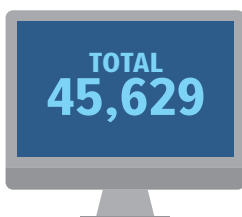

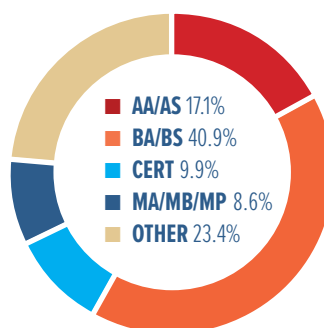

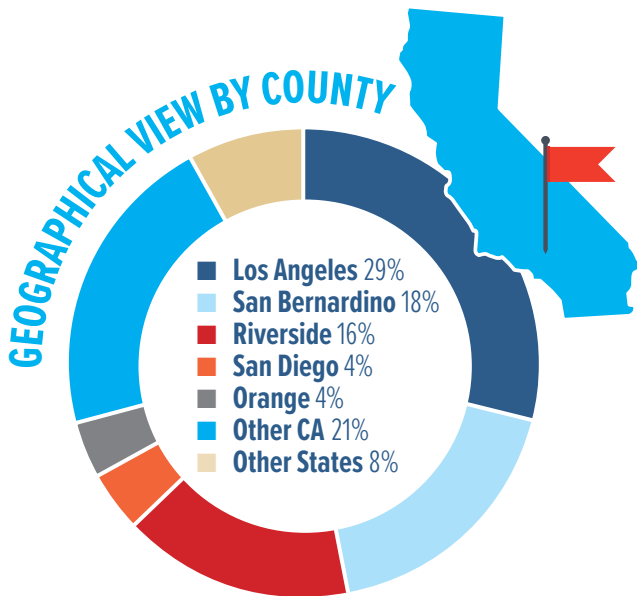

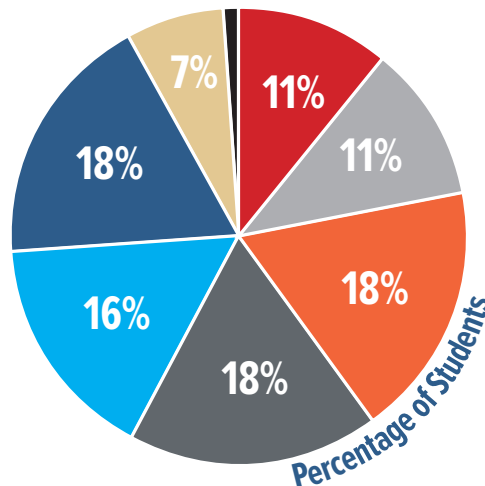

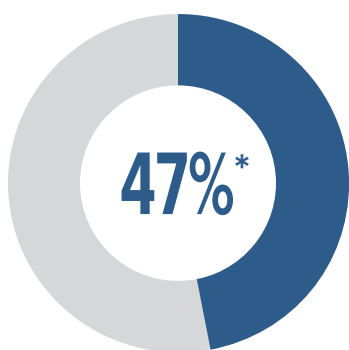

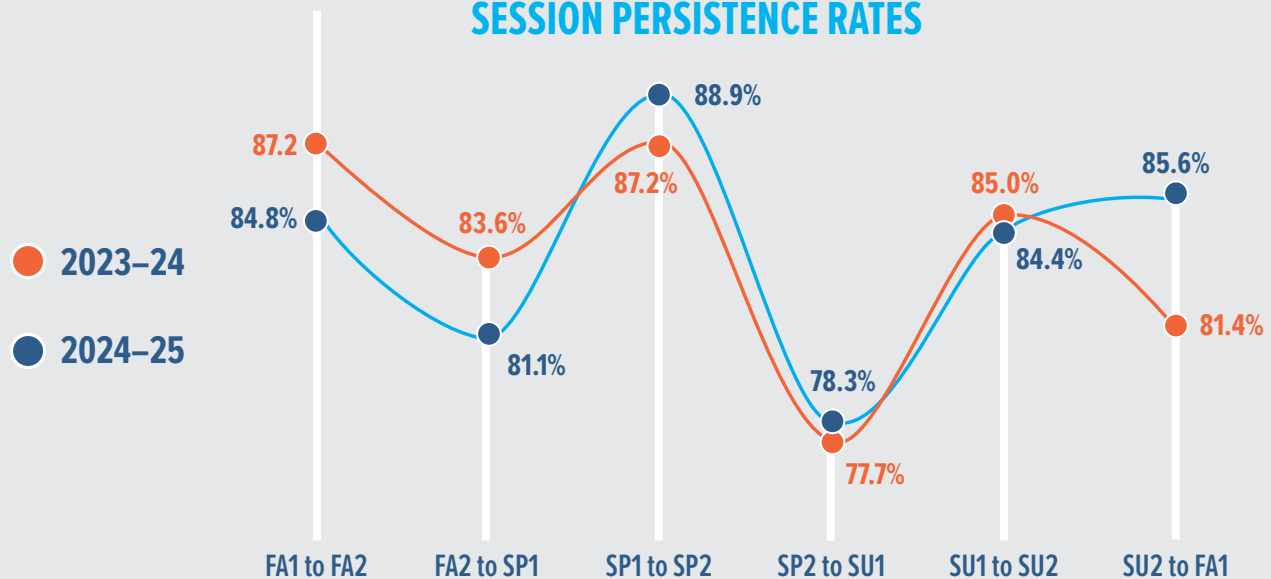

SESSION PERSISTENCE RATES



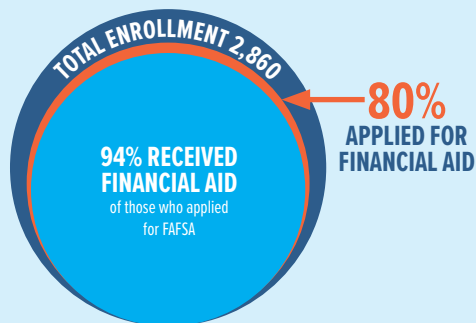

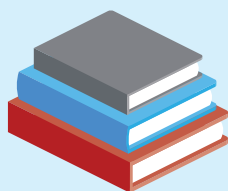

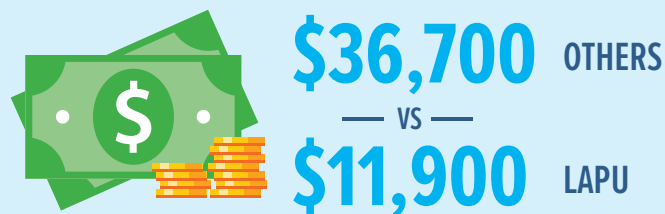
